E. Village Estates, Tract 4198-C; T18N, R22W, Section 3; Request for a Final Water Allocation for 63 Lots.

Discussion and possible action to approve the final water allocation for Tract 4198-C for 21.42 acre feet of water. Staff advised the board that Tract 4198-C has been granted a Final Plat by Mohave County at their February 18, 2020 regular board meeting with resolution 2020-027 and we have a copy of the signed Final Plat and all fees for Tract 4198-C have been paid in full. Vince Vasquez made a motion to approve the final water allocation for Tract 4198-C, Perry Muscelli seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed. Kai, - Y; Muscelli – Y; Vanderslice – Y; Vasquez – Y; Sherrill – Y

F. Village Estates, Tracts 4198-D through 4198-G; T18N, R22W, Section 3; Request for an Extension of Preliminary Water Allocation for phases D - G.

Discussion and possible action to approve the extension request of the preliminary water allocation for:

- Tract 4198D 29 lots for 9.86 acre feet;
- Tract 4198D Parcel A – Clubhouse & Pool 2.38 acre feet
- Tract 4198E 46 lots for 15.64 acre feet;
- Tract 4198F 63 lots for 21.42 acre feet;
- Tract 4198G 92 lots for 31.28 acre feet.

Staff advised this is the same subdivision from the prior item that was just approved and they are requesting an extension of their preliminary water

allocation for another 2 years for tracts 4198-D through 4198-G. They have been making great progress and have submitted for the final plat for Tract 4198-D and Parcel A with Mohave County Development Services. They have also paid for the water allocation extension administration fee. Perry Muscelli made a motion to approve the 24 month extension, Vince Vasquez seconded the motion. This new extension will expire on November 10, 2022. All in favor, motion passed. Kai, - Y; Muscelli – Y; Vanderslice – Y; Vasquez – Y; Sherrill –Y.

- G. **Twin Palms Estates, Tract 4189-B; T19N, R22W, Section 36; Request for a Final Water Allocation for 47 lots.** Discussion and possible action to approve the final water allocation for Tract 4189-B for 15.98 acre feet of water. Staff called Mr. Dewey Davide on the conference line to attend the meeting. Staff advised this is a request for a final water allocation for Twin Palms, Tract 4189-B and this was granted a Final Plat by Mohave County at their August 03, 2020 regular board meeting with resolution 2020-106 and we have a copy of the signed Final Plat and all fees for Tract 4189-B have been paid in full. Perry Muscelli made a motion to approve the final water allocation, John Kai, Jr., seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed. Kai, - Y; Muscelli – Y; Vanderslice – Y; Vasquez – Y; Sherrill – Y
- H. **Powers-Leavitt Insurance Agency, Inc.** Discussion and possible action to approve the Insurance Proposal for November 08, 2020 to November 08, 2021. Staff summarized the proposal for insurance and advised the board of last year's fees, however this year they include a company vehicle. Perry Muscelli made a motion to approve the insurance proposal for the next upcoming year, Clay Vanderslice seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed. - I. ***Draft System Conservation Implementation Agreement (SCIA) between BOR and MVIDD.** Discussion and possible action to approve the SCIA agreement. District counsel summarized the draft system conservation agreement status with the board members and recommended that we not take a formal action on the contract until he has addressed a couple of items with the Bureau of Reclamation, however, he recommends taking a vote of confidence to allow for him to address the BOR with the boards questions. Perry Muscelli made a motion for a vote of confidence and to have district counsel address any items and then bring this back to the board for final action, Vince Vasquez seconded the motion.
