Discussion and possible action regarding the application. Staff reviewed the AG to Urban water transfer application with the Board of Directors. - F. Coyote Run, Tract 4176B; T19N, R22W Section 23; APN(s): 228-04-310; Final Water Allocation Request for 41 Single-Family Lots; Parcel F will be a Utility and Drainage Easement Only. Discussion and possible action regarding the request. Staff reviewed the final approved plat from Mohave County with the Board of Directors, Vince Vasquez made a motion to approve the final water allocation, Clay Vanderslice seconded the motion. - G. Coyote Run, Tract 4176C & D; T19N, R22W, Section 23; APN(s): 228-04-355; Request for a 24-Month Extension of the Preliminary Water Allocation for 18.36-Acre Feet of Water. Discussion and possible action regarding the extension request. Staff reviewed the extension request with the Board of Directors, Perry Muscelli wanted to know if the CLOMR was a condition needed for Mohave County. Mr. Sam Elters, Mohave County Manager, advised that it is. Vince Vasquez made a motion to approve an 18-month extension, Perry Muscelli seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed. Kai Y; Muscelli Y; Vanderslice Y; Vasquez Y; Sherrill Y.
- H. The Hills at Cielo Los Lagos; T18N, R22W, Section 01; APN(s): 225-71-395A; Application for an AG to Urban Water Transfer from AG Contract 2012-04C (WPI-919 Farm) in Section 30 for 25.23-Acre Feet of Preliminary Water for 68 Total Units and Minimal Landscaping. Discussion and possible action regarding the application. Staff reviewed the AG to Urban Water transfer application with the Board of Directors. Vince Vasquez recused himself from this item. Clay Vanderslice made a motion to approve the transfer, Perry Muscelli seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed. Kai Y, Vanderslice Y; Muscelli Y; Vasquez -A; Sherrill Y.
- I. Estimates for Security Cameras for the District office. Discussion and possible action regarding installing security cameras at the District office. No action

taken. Mr. Perry Muscelli advised staff that he has a better solution at a lower cost and to follow up with him.

- J. Marina Coves Homeowners Association; Amenity Contract 2016-05; 500-Acre Feet; Request for a Ten-Year Extension of this Amenity Contract.

 Discussion and possible action regarding the request. No action taken, Chairman, Chip Sherrill advised that at this time, the District cannot renew the Amenity Contracts, it is still too early to know what curtailments the District may be facing. Chip suggested that the Amenity users, District staff, legal counsel, and a couple of board members start having some meaningful conversations regarding future water allocations. Representatives for Marina Coves HOA spoke to their concerns and are hopeful of continuing to work with the District regarding the renewal of the Amenity Contracts.
- K. **Herb Kai Farm Unit; Contract 2008-07; T17N, R22W, Section 09; APN(s): 224-19-001. Notice of Public Nuisance to Abate Noxious Weeds. Discussion only with the board of directors regarding this notice. Staff reviewed items 8K through 8N with the Board of Directors. Staff is seeking guidance only on how to proceed. The Board of Directors directed staff to invoke the District Policy regarding Noxious Weed Abatement. The Board of Directors also suggested having a special meeting in a couple of weeks to see what progress has been made with the farm units. No further action taken at this time. This discussion was noted to apply equally to Items L, M, and N below.
- L. **Herb Kai Farm Unit; Contract 2008-08; T17N, R22W, Section 13; APN(s): 224-23-019. Notice of Public Nuisance to Abate Noxious Weeds. Discussion only with the board of directors regarding this notice.
- M. **John Kai Farm Unit; Contract 2008-06CA; T18N, R22W, Section 27; APN(s): 225-26-064, 060, & 089. Notice of Public Nuisance to Abate Noxious Weeds. Discussion only with the board of directors regarding this notice.
- N. **John Kai Farm Unit; Contract 2017-01A; T18N, R22W, Section 23; APN(s): 225-24-044 & 025. Notice of Public Nuisance to Abate Noxious Weeds. Discussion only with the board of directors regarding this notice.
